

Route

This tour begins at City Centre Community Centre. From the Centre, ride on Minoru Blvd south to the Cultural Centre. Using the Granville Ave bike lane, ride towards Thompson Community Centre until you meet the Railway Greenway. Turn west on Francis Rd and south on No. 1 Rd to find West Richmond Community Centre (Spot #6 & #7). Return back to the Greenway afterwards. Head south on the Greenway until you reach Spot #8 at Branscombe House, where you will find a picnic table and lawns that make a great lunch spot. Turn back and ride north to Williams Rd. Turn right onto Williams Rd and ride until you see Ash St. Turn left onto Ash St and turn left on Keefer St and look for Paulik Neighbourhood Park. After visiting the Park (Spots #11 & #12) head north on Heather St to Granville Ave. Turn left (west) onto Granville to return to the city centre.

Cycling Regulations & Safe Cycling Tips

- Wear a helmet
- Obey traffic signs and signals
- Use lights at night and wear reflective clothing
- Ride in single file
- Stay off sidewalks unless otherwise directed by signs
- Dismount at noted crossings
- Yield right-of-way to pedestrians
