Purpose:

Ensure Operator(s) of an Amusement Centre are aware of and follow the regulations stated in Part FIVE of Business Regulation Bylaw 7538.

Definition:

Amusement Centre, which includes an amusement arcade, means any premises where five or more devices or machines, mechanically, electronically, or otherwise operated, are available for the amusement and enjoyment of the public, but excludes carnival rides.

General Procedures:

If **5 or more** machines and the site address is not currently on the list of approved business premise (see attached *Schedule A to Business Regulation Bylaw 7538*) the applicant must apply requesting a report to Council for approval.

Amusement machines must not be used for the purpose of gambling unless the premise is licensed as a casino by the appropriate Provincial Authority.

Internet Café is considered an Amusement Centre if more than five computers are onsite for use by patrons.
