Spectacle of Lights

Santa visits Steveston



'Tis the season to be jolly and there's no better way to get in the mood than looking at the twinkling lights, going on a winter hayride and having Santa visit from the North Pole.

Festivities begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, December 7. The Steveston Community Centre hay-wagon, with Santa on board, will start at the corner of No. 1 Road and Moncton Street and lead an illuminated musical procession down Moncton to Fisherman's Park. The procession will conclude outside the Gulf of Georgia Cannery National Historic Site, where local dignitaries will light a grand sequoia Christmas tree.

After the tree lighting, enjoy some free entertainment in the park and do some late night shopping in the Village. Pre-registered hayrides will run throughout the evening. They are \$5 per person and spots are filling up quickly. Register online at www.richmond.ca.

On Saturday, December 8, bring a camera and take a picture with Santa when he visits the Village of Steveston.
