Lawn sprinkling restrictions

June 1 – September 30



During the summer months, City of Richmond residents are reminded of the lawn sprinkling regulations that are in effect throughout Metro Vancouver. From June 1 to September 30, lawn sprinkling is allowed only from 4:00 – 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 – 10:00 p.m. on the following days:

- **Even-numbered** addresses can sprinkle *Wednesdays and Saturdays*.
- **Odd-numbered** addresses can sprinkle *Thursdays and Sundays*.

While these regulations apply only to lawns, residents and businesses are encouraged to think about water conservation, especially during the peak demand period of summer.
