Excerpt from Dog Licencing Bylaw No. 7138 & Animal Control Regulation Bylaw No. 7932:

- Every dog over 8 weeks old must be licensed.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on any street or public place unless in designated areas.
- The City of Richmond has a limit of three (3) dogs per one family dwelling; maximum of two (2) dogs per multiple family dwelling.

A non-refundable dog licence can be obtained at Richmond City Hall by:

- visiting Richmond City Hall with your completed application; payment must be made by cash, debit or cheque only;
- dropping off your completed application form with your cheque/money order in the drop boxes available at the Richmond Community Centres/Arenas/Pools (Thompson, South Arm, Steveston, Cambie and West Richmond). Early payment is accepted from November 1, 2011 to February 29, 2012; or
- mailing this application with your cheque/money order payable to:
The City of Richmond, 6911 No. 3 Road, Richmond, BC V6Y 2C1, **Attention: Dog Licensing.**

A replacement dog licence, for lost or valid out-of-jurisdiction licence, can be obtained at City Hall for \$5.25.
