

Paulik Gardens Neighbourhood Park



Paulik Gardens Neighbourhood Park is located between Heather and Ash Streets, just south of General Currie Road. The park encompasses features that illustrate the areas past. At the north west end are remnants of the Lulu Island Water Garden, a small commercial operation that sold water plants, frogs and flowering bulbs. The south end, originally owned by the Paulik family, has a large number of coniferous trees and ornamental garden that showcases a collection of rhododendrons and flowering perennials. Blueberry shrubs, found on the east side of the park are a reminder of the area's agricultural past. The City of Richmond opened the park to the public in June 2005. The Richmond Garden Club adopted the park in 2008. Their dedicated volunteers are both park ambassadors and gardeners.

Paulik Gardens Neighbourhood Park is open daily from dawn to dusk and is located at 7620 Heather Street. There are no public washrooms and parking is very limited. For more information about the park and programs, call 604-244-1208.
