All artists selected for the RICHmond ARTS exhibition will be invited to bring small art related items to sell. The Gallery will take a 20% commission on all sales from the event.

ELIGIBILITY

1. There is a non-refundable fee to submit work to be considered for this exhibition: \$15 for RAGA members and \$20 for non-members.
2. Each artist may submit one work for consideration by the jury. Additional works will not be accepted.
3. Original artwork only. The jury will consider the degree of skill or mastery expressed in the medium utilized, as well as adherence to the theme.
4. Artwork must be exhibition ready – 2-D artwork should be framed with hanging wire on the back and 3-D work should be ready to display. If there are special hanging or display instructions, please include them with this application form.
5. Please note that the Richmond Art Gallery will manage all sales of artwork from the exhibition; a 50% commission will be taken off of the sale price.

Please include a cheque for the non-refundable fee payable to the Richmond Art Gallery Association, along with this application form, with your artwork when it is delivered for jurying on June 4, 2007.

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

Delivery of artwork to be juried: Monday, June 4 between 11am – 2pm and 5 – 7pm in the Lecture Hall of the Cultural Centre.

Jury to chose artwork for exhibition: Tuesday, June 5. Artists whose work isn't selected will be notified by phone on the evening of Tuesday, June 5.

Pick-up for artwork not selected by jury: Wednesday, June 6 between 11am – 2pm and 5 – 7pm in the Lecture Hall of the Cultural Centre. The Gallery will not be responsible for artwork left after that date.

Opening Reception: Thursday, June 7, 6:30 - 8:30pm.

Exhibition Dates: June 8 – July 6, 2007.

Art Market Day: June 23, 10am – 5pm in the Lecture Hall of the Cultural Centre.

Pick-up of artwork from exhibition: Friday, July 6 from 6 – 9pm from the Gallery. No exceptions, the Gallery will not be responsible for artwork left after that date.

Open Studios: Saturday and Sunday, July 7 and 8 from Noon to 4pm.
