Development Permit Panel Meeting

Agenda Items:

1. 8140 and 8160 Park Road (DP 07-402052) - Andrew Cheung Architects Inc. - To (1) permit the construction of a mixed-use commercial and residential development consisting of a 14-storey tower with a total of 99 residential units, including eight (8) Affordable Housing units and approximately 457.8 m² (4,928 ft²) of retail/commercial space at street level on a site zoned "Downtown Commercial District (C7)"; and (2) vary the provisions of the Zoning and Development Bylaw to: (a) reduce the number of parking spaces for each residential unit from 1.5 parking spaces per dwelling unit to 1.0 parking spaces per dwelling unit; (b) reduce the number of parking spaces for each Affordable Housing unit from 1.2 (resident and visitor) parking spaces per dwelling unit to 1.1 (resident and visitor) parking spaces per dwelling unit; and (c) reduce the minimum Public Road setback from 3.0 m to 1.8 m along Park Road.

2. 7620 Acheson Road (DP 08-442688) - Timothy Tse - To (1) permit the construction of two (2) front-to-back duplexes on a site zoned "Comprehensive Development District (CD/28)"; and (2) vary the provisions of the Zoning and Development Bylaw to permit portions of the second storey of the buildings to project beyond the residential vertical envelope (lot depth) to a maximum of 1.5 m (5.0 ft).
