Celebrate environmental sustainability



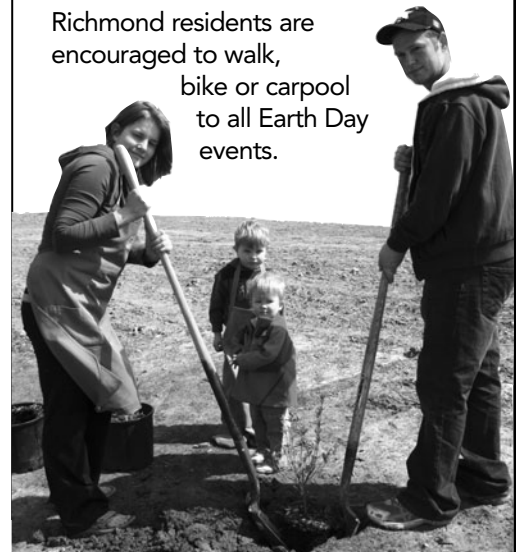
