1. 4071, 4091, 4111 and 4131 No. 4 Road — DP 09-486487 — Fortuna Development Inc. — To (1) permit the construction of 26 three-storey town house units at 4071, 4091, 4111 and 4131 No. 4 Road on a site zoned "Town Housing (ZT67)"; and (2) vary the provisions of Richmond Zoning Bylaw 8500 to: (a) reduce the minimum lot size from 0.5 ha (1.24 ac) to 0.45 ha (1.11 ac); and (b) reduce the minimum south side yard setback from 3.0 m to


1.62 m to allow a freestanding garbage and recycling enclosure to encroach into the side yard setback.
