1. 7300, 7340, 7360, 7380 and 7420 Blundell Road -- DP 10-519994 -- Hi-Quality Properties Ltd. -- To (1) permit the construction of 26 townhouse units at 7300, 7340, 7360, 7380 and 7420 Blundell Road on a site zoned Low Density Townhouses (RTL3); and (2) vary the provisions of Richmond Zoning Bylaw 8500 to: (a) reduce the minimum front yard setback from 6.0 m to 4.95 m for Building No. 1; (b) reduce the minimum front yard setback from 6.0 m to 5.20 m for Building No. 10; and (c) reduce the minimum west side yard setback from 3.0 m to 1.98 m for Building No. 9.
