

## **EXTRA GARBAGE?**

For the occasions when residents have extra garbage, the City offers a number of options:

- Residents have the opportunity to exchange their cart for a different size, and their curbside garbage collection fees will be adjusted according to the size selected. There is a \$25 charge for cart exchanges. For more details on the size of carts and the related curbside garbage collection rates, please visit www.richmond.ca/garbage. To exchange your garbage cart, call Environmental Programs at 604-276-4010 or email garbageandrecycling@richmond.ca.
- Residents can purchase \$2 Garbage Tags for excess garbage bags/cans as needed.
- Use Richmond's Large Item Pick Up program for curbside collection of up to four large items each year. To schedule a large item pick up, residents can call the City's service provider, Sierra Waste Services at 604-270-4722.
- A \$5 Garbage Disposal Voucher for the Vancouver Landfill (one per Richmond household per year) can be purchased at City facilities. The voucher is good for up to \$25 in value for garbage drop off at the Vancouver Landfill located at 5400 72nd Street, Delta. For more information, call 604-276-4010.

## **HOW TO GET YOUR COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

To find out your collection day, please download the Richmond Collection Schedule App at the Apple and Android app stores or online at www.richmond.ca/recycle and sign up for weekly reminders. The app also includes a Recycling Wizard – a simple tool to find out where to recycle a wide variety of household items.

**GARBAGE PICKUP:** Place garbage cart at the designated location in your complex by 7:30 a.m. on your collection day (or no earlier than 8 p.m. the night before)

**REMINDER:** It's important to wrap or secure garbage to prevent loose materials from being scattered by wind or animals.

## ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED IN THE GARBAGE CART

The following items are recyclable and therefore are not permitted in the garbage cart. Disposal solutions provided:



Food scraps and yard trimmings Recycle with Green Cart.



#### Hazardous materials, such as pesticides, flammable liquids, asbestos, automotive body and parts, medications and lead acid batteries

Take to a drop-off location near you. For a list of accepted items and drop-off options, see Banned & Prohibited Materials at www.richmond.ca/recycle.



# Recyclable items, such as electronics, including computers, printers, televisions, radios, and batteries

Take to a recycling drop-off location near you. For a list of accepted items and drop-off options, see Take Back Programs at www.richmond.ca/recycle or use the Recycling Wizard within the Richmond Collection Schedule app.



#### Paper, newspaper, cardboard, plastic containers, empty aerosol cans, tin and aluminium cans, and glass bottles and jars

Recycle with the Blue Box or Blue Cart program (unless the paper is contaminated by non-food waste). Remember to recycle glass separately using the Glass Recycling Bin/Glass Recycling Cart.
