Composting at Home

Home composting bins, as well as rain barrels, are available for purchase at the Richmond Recycling Depot.

ADDITIONAL HOUSEHOLD WASTE


The Richmond Recycling Depot sells Garbage Tags and Garbage Disposal Vouchers for additional household waste.

\$2 Garbage Tags

Use for additional waste for curbside collection. One Garbage Tag must be present on each additional garbage can or bag (100 L maximum size).

\$5 Garbage Disposal Voucher

Use at the Vancouver Landfill. Covers \$25 in disposal charges. Limit one per household per year.

Welcome to the Richmond Recycling Depot

You'll be amazed by how much you can take – for free – to the Richmond Recycling Depot. Open seven days a week, it's easy and convenient to drop off multiple items for safe recycling. Visit richmond.ca/depot for the most up-to-date list of accepted items.

Use the map below to see where to take your items once you arrive at the Recycling Depot. The icons are colour coded to match the signs at the Depot and help you quickly find your way. There are always attendants available to help you and to safely handle hazardous recyclable items.

YARD AND GARDEN TRIMMINGS DROP OFF LIMITS AND FEES

Up to 1 cubic yard at no charge for Richmond residents; branches must be no more than 10 cm (4 in) in diameter. Each additional cubic yard is \$20, or drop off an unlimited amount of yard trimmings at Ecowaste Industries free of charge. Proof of residency is required. Visit ecowaste.com or call 604-277-1410.

Note: Commercial operators are charged \$20 per 1 cubic yard for all trimmings at the Richmond Recycling Depot.





There is a drop-off limit of 1 cubic yard of material per day (approximately one small pickup truck load).

- ✓ Corrugated cardboard
- ✓ Electronics
- ✓ Empty aerosol & spiral wound cans

- ✓ Exercise & hobby machines
- ✓ Fire extinguishers
- ✓ Flammable aerosols or liquids
- ✓ Flexible plastic packaging (crinkly wrappers, stand up & zipper lock pouches, etc.)
- ✓ Fluorescent lamps including compact fluorescent lights & fluorescent tubes
- ✓ Glass food & beverage containers
- ✓ Large appliances
- ✓ Lead acid batteries
- ✓ Lights & lighting fixtures
- ✓ Mixed paper (cereal/paper) boxes, clean pizza boxes, magazines, flyers, paper egg cartons, etc.)
- ✓ Motor oil, oil filters & antifreeze

- ✓ Paint, solvents, pesticides & gasoline
- ✓ Plastic bags & overwrap
- ✓ Polystyrene foam (e.g. Styrofoam)
- ✓ Propane tanks
- ✓ Rigid plastic
- ✓ Scrap metal
- ✓ Sewing, knitting & textile machines
- ✓ Small appliances & power tools
- ✓ Smoke & carbon monoxide alarms
- ✓ Tin & aluminium cans
