Apartment / Condominium Security Tips

Building Exterior

- Intercom directories should list only your last name and, if necessary, an initial. Suite numbers should not be displayed.
- Do not let anyone into the building unless you know they currently live in the building.
- Don't buzz anyone into the building through the intercom unless you are expecting them.
- Wait for the parking security gates to close behind you.
- Do not leave external doors propped open.
- Ensure fences or trees do not allow access to balconies.
- Do not leave valuables on your balcony.
- Use caution when alone in the laundry or storage room.
- Never store valuables in your storage locker.

Inside Your Suite

- Re-keyed your locks when moving in.
- Do not rely on door chains, they can be forced open.
- When away, cancel your newspaper and ask a trusted friend to collect your mail.
