Appearance Matters!

The appearance and layout of a business can attract or deter crimes. Business owners have to set up numerous lines of defense to keep thieves out, starting from the surrounding area to the inside of the store.

- Promptly remove graffiti and garbage around the building
- Make sure all entrances and parking areas around the building are well lit
- Remove any large objects near the building which people could use to hide behind
- Secure doors with proper locks and alarms
- Install bollards within the sidewalk to prevent vehicles from ramming and smashing through your doors and windows
- Install break resistant glass
- Storage areas are not visible to the public and secured, during and after business hours
- Install anti-pry plating on all doors
- All screws securing the door and the frame have to be at least 3 inches long
- Install high resolution surveillance camera both inside and outside
- Keep expensive merchandise locked up and away from doors and windows
- Eliminate blind spots in the store
