



**Additional Hotel Room Tax Imposition Bylaw No. 8471, Amendment
Bylaw No. 8899**

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

- 1. That Additional Hotel Room Tax Imposition Bylaw No. 8471 is amended by deleting section 4 and replacing it with:

“4. The purposes for which the amount paid to the City of Richmond out of the revenue collected from the tax to be imposed under the provisions of the regulation referred to in section 2 of this Bylaw may be expended are

- (a) tourism marketing, programs and projects;*
- (b) sport hosting marketing, programs and projects;*
- (c) construction and operation of tourism destination enhancing attractions (including construction or renovation of infrastructure); and*
- (d) production of major events.”*

- 2. This bylaw is cited as “Additional Hotel Room Tax Imposition Bylaw No. 8471, Amendment Bylaw No. 8899”.
