Staff Report

Origin

James Robert Anderson and Jackie Randolph Nishikawa started their employment with the City of Richmond as Bylaw Liaison Officers for the purposes of bylaw enforcement on December 17, 2007.

Mr. Anderson is assuming an existing budgeted position on a Temporary Full-Time basis due to a temporary re-assignment of the incumbent Officer in City Hall.

Mr. Nishikawa is assuming an existing budgeted position on a Regular Full-Time basis due to the resignation of the incumbent Officer.

Analysis

In the discharge of their normal duties, it is appropriate to provide the new Bylaw Liaison Officers the ability to issue both Municipal Ticket Information (MTI) tickets and Notices of Bylaw Violation.

Under provisions of the Offence Act, for the purposes of the service of summons in respect of an alleged offence under a bylaw of a Municipality, a Peace Officer includes Bylaw Enforcement Officers as appointed under the Police Act.

Financial Impact

None.

Conclusion

It is recommended that James Robert Anderson and Jackie Randolph Nishikawa be appointed as Bylaw Enforcement Officers, in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons and, as permitted, the issuance of tickets under the authority of applicable Municipal Bylaws.


