Applicants from Richmond are given preference, but artists' applications from other British Columbia localities may be considered. Artworks may include paintings, drawings, photographs, textile work, ceramics and can be displayed on paper, canvas or in frames. Free-standing pieces cannot be accommodated in any of these spaces.

Various including 2 vitrines for free standing pieces.

South Arm Community Centre

Though submissions are accepted year round we strongly recommend sending packages by 5pm on July 31, 2016 in order to be considered during our August committee meeting.

All information provided under the submission shall be considered confidential and shall only be disseminated to City staff and partners for the purposes of the selection process. All submissions become the property of the City and will be held in confidence as required by law. The artist shall retain copyright.

While every precaution will be taken to prevent the loss or damage of submissions, the City and its agents shall not be liable for any loss or damage, however caused.

No fee is provided to the artist and insurance for the art work is the responsibility of the artist. The City reserves the right to modify the exhibition schedule.
