## Staff Report

### Origin

As part of the City's Long Term Financial Management Strategy Policy 3707, it was recommended that fees and charges should be adjusted annually based on CPI increases. The City currently has numerous bylaws that impose fees and charges for services, licenses, and usage rights. In order to ensure that all fees and charges are reviewed annually, Staff proposes the consolidation of fees from various bylaws into the Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636 and to amend existing bylaws with the Consolidated Fees Bylaw – Consequential Repeals & Amendments Bylaw No. 8637.

### Analysis

Consolidating various fees and charges into one bylaw allows for:

- the streamlining of bylaw amendments for fee changes resulting from inflation or CPI adjustments
- all fees in the Consolidated Fees Bylaw to be reviewed on an annual basis; and
- the creation of a single document for the majority of the fees charged by the City and allows users to view these fees under one bylaw

Fees and charges are currently embedded in numerous bylaws and are the responsibility of various stakeholders throughout the City. Incorporating all of the City's current fees and charges onto the Consolidated Fees Bylaw ("CFB") at this time would require dedicated effort in locating the charges of each bylaw, and to determine whether it should be part of the CFB. Currently, the fees and charges included in the proposed CFB are just a portion of the fees that the City charges. The CFB will be amended from time to time to include other identified charges that is determined to be well suited for CPI increases.

Fees and charges from the following bylaws were omitted from the CFB because the charges are reviewed annually and are affected by factors other than inflation:

- Development Cost Charges
- Fees imposed by bylaws that undergo rate adjustments based on factors other than inflation (eg: Property Tax, Waterworks and Water Rates, Solid Waste and Recycling, etc)

Due to timing restrictions, the Business Licence Bylaw 7360, Amendment Bylaw 8654 was introduced to Council on October 25, 2010 with rate changes for 2011. As a result, Business Licence Fees is not included in this CFB but will be included in the bylaw for 2012 rate adjustments.

Aquatic and arena fees are determined by the boards of the various community associations and therefore not included in this bylaw.

Upon the drafting of the consolidated fee bylaw, it was noted that many fees and charges have not changed in the past years for inflation. Attached is a copy of the Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636 with the proposed 1.5% increase adjusted for CPI, effective 30 days after the adoption

of the bylaw. To minimize transactions requiring small coins, all adjusted fees greater than \$100 are rounded to the nearest \$1.00. Adjusted fees less than \$100 are rounded to the nearest \$0.25.

Although many fees increased by 1.5%, the following fees in the CFB were not adjusted for CPI:

- Dog Licencing Fees -  
A report to the Community Safety Committee on October 13<sup>th</sup> proposed that existing dog licencing fees remain unchanged for 2011.
- Filming Applications and Fees -  
The Manager of Business Liaison and Film Office is currently reviewing the fee structure for filming application and fees.
- RCMP Documentation Fees -  
Many of the fees originally priced at \$51 will be increased to \$55 to bring fees in line with other municipalities.

In addition to these changes, the CFB enables staff to add fees and charges to the bylaw that the City is currently collecting but is not a part of any existing bylaw. These fees include:

- publication fees
- Billing and Receivable Charges which includes:
  - administrative charges that allow the City to recover costs incurred with respect to administration and processing of receivable billings for services provided to third parties.
  - NSF charges where cheques are returned by the bank due to insufficient funds in clients' bank accounts.
- The inclusion of false alarm charges to section 3.1.3.5 of the Public Health Protection Bylaw. This fee was originally charged under Fire and Security Alarm System Regulation Bylaw No. 7362. When the bylaw was repealed in 2008, the reference to the RCMP attendance fee was accidentally omitted from the bylaw.

Pursuit to Council Policy 9311 – Business Regulation Bylaw Notification, the adoption of the proposed bylaw will be advertised once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper that is distributed in Richmond after the first, second, and third readings and before the final adoption of the bylaw.

### **Financial Impact**

Fee increases offset CPI and therefore has little or no financial impact to the City.

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City of Richmond

Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636

A bylaw to impose fees in respect of the services and the property of the City of Richmond.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Richmond considers it necessary and desirable to impose fees for the provision of its services and the use of its property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

PART ONE: CITATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as "Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636".
1.2 This bylaw comes into force and effect 30 days after the adoption of this bylaw.

PART TWO: FEES

- 2.1 The City of Richmond imposes fees for the provision of its services and the use of its property as specified in the Schedules attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
2.2 Where applicable, Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) will be added to the fees specified in the Schedules attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
2.3 Terms defined in the specified bylaws carry the same meanings in this bylaw.

PART THREE: SEVERABILITY

- 3.1 If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid and set aside by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw shall be valid.

with: "a non-refundable fee in the amount set from time to time in the Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636" is payable for each inspection after the second inspection";

(vii) the following is added: "**Part Twelve: Fees Bylaw 12.1** The Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636, as may be amended from time to time, applies to this bylaw.";

(o) Water Use Restriction Bylaw No. 7784:

(i) in section 3.1.2 of Part Three the words "of \$30.00" are deleted and replaced: with "in the amount set from time to time in the Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636";

(ii) the following is added: "**Part Nine: Fees Bylaw 9.1** The Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 8636, as may be amended from time to time, applies to this bylaw.".

**PART THREE: SEVERABILITY**

3.1 If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid and set aside by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw shall be valid.

**PART FOUR: CITATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE**

4.1 This Bylaw is cited as "**Consolidated Fees Bylaw - Consequential Repeal And Amendments Bylaw No. 8637**".

4.2 This Bylaw comes into force and effect 30 days after the adoption of this bylaw.

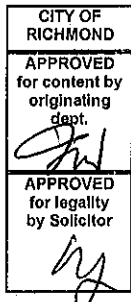
