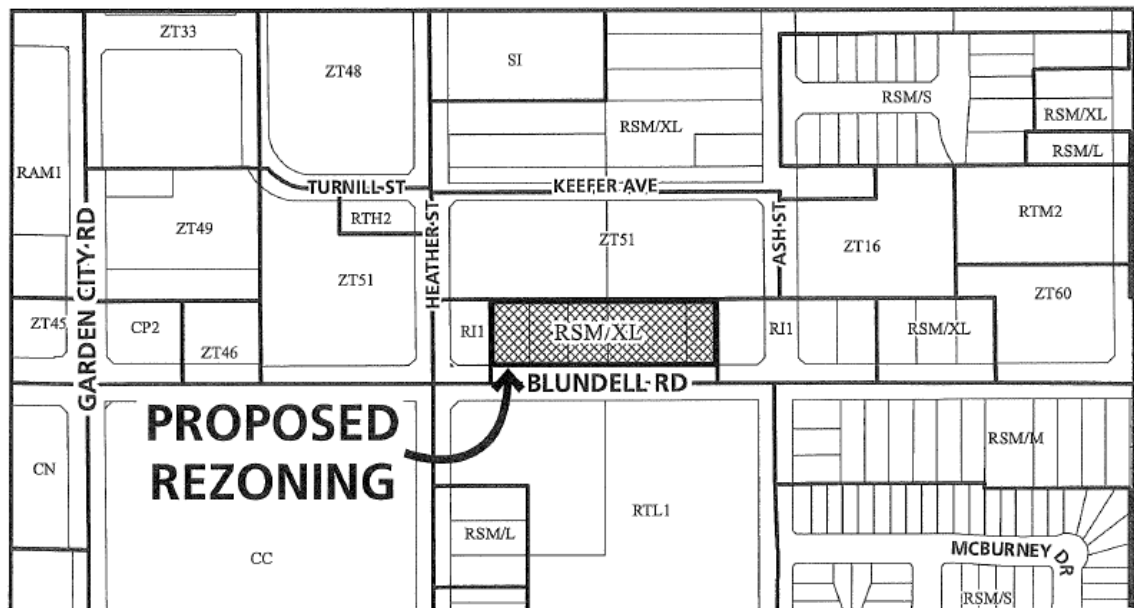
1. RICHMOND ZONING BYLAW 8500, AMENDMENT BYLAW 10737 (RZ 22-017350)

Location/s: 9211, 9251, 9291, 9311, 9351 Blundell Road

Applicant/s: Interface Architecture Inc.

Purpose: To rezone the subject property from the “Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing (RSM/XL)” zone to the “High Density Townhouses (RTH2)” zone, to permit development of 30 townhouse units (including three secondary suites), with vehicle access to Blundell Road.

2. RICHMOND ZONING BYLAW 8500, AMENDMENT BYLAW 10795 and 10796 (RZ 23-035646)

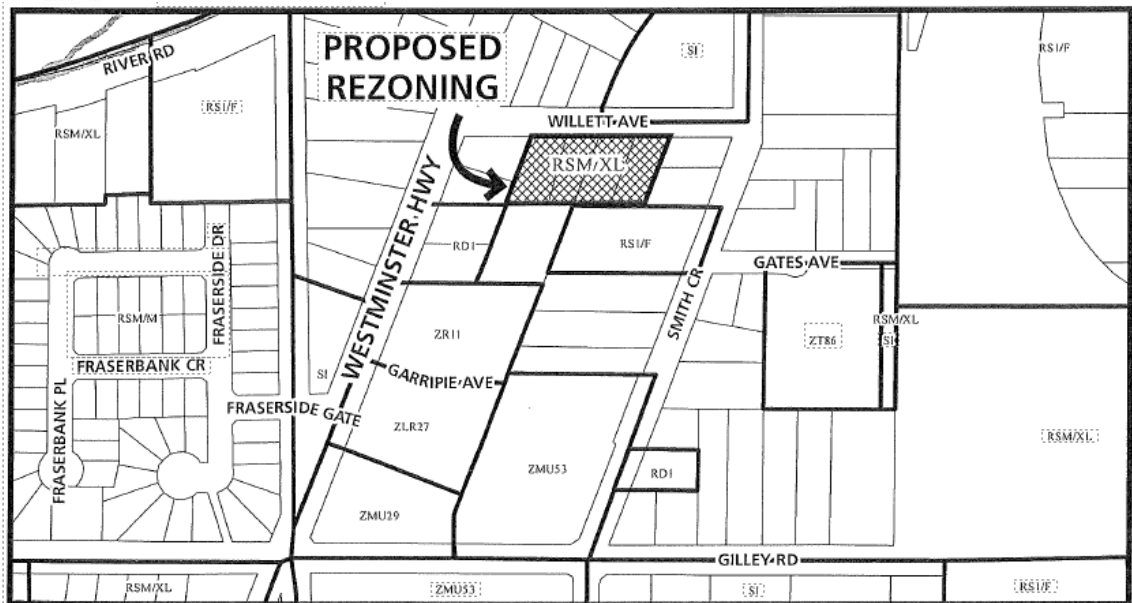
Location/s: 23160, 23180, 23200 and 23220 Willett Avenue

Applicant/s: Kei Canada Willett Development Ltd.

Purpose: **Bylaw 10795** – To create the “Town Housing (ZT108) – Willett Avenue (Hamilton)” zone.

Bylaw 10796 - To rezone the subject property from “Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing (RSM/XL)” to “Town Housing (ZT108) – Willett Avenue (Hamilton)”, to permit development of 33 townhouse units.
