- School Board makes up budget, first approved by council then Victoria for final approval.
- Board never had the right to do its won financing.

Maintenance - no maintenance staff , thus board members checked.

Construction

- Find accommodation for growing population
- R.M. Grauer School
- Richmond High School
- Burkeville
- Several annexes and gymnasiums (new to the schools at time)

School Referendums

- School construction by referendums
- Richmond High School was a major defeat, later approved but had cut out auditorium cost increase

School Fires

- Lord Byng School talks about insurance difficulties
- Cook School burnt chiefly because there was no water in the hydrants

New Staff & Equipment

- No outside maintenance, sub-contracted in the summer, first supervisors of maintenance hired
- First gardener hired
- Power lawn-mower first one purchased

Teachers

- Hired by School Board on advice of inspector - tells of procedure.

Contributions

- Chiefly speaking to the taxpayer regarding the proposed referendums
- Had been chairman on the board nine out of the ten years.
