Q: When is the BC Seniors Week Opening Event?

Q: Is registration required for the Opening Event?

- A: Yes, registration can be done online, by phone or in-person at any community facility
- Use Event ID #238430 for the event and #236497 for wheelchair and scooter seating

 - In-person at any community facility

Q: What will the Opening Event include?

- A: Theme "Seniors in the Spotlight"
 - Live entertainment featuring seniors from across Richmond showcasing their talents
 - o Light refreshments including cookies, coffee and tea provided

Q: Is there parking at the Opening Event?

- A: Yes, however the parking lot is limited
 - Carpool or shuttle service is preferred
 - Parking at Gateway Theatre is free for this event

Q: Is transportation provided to and from the Opening Event?

- A: Yes, registration is required with transportation provided for free
 - Pick up and drop off will be at your preferred community centre (list below)
 - Transportation users will receive a phone call before the event for pick up times
 - Departure back to the community centres will be available at approximately 1:00pm from Gateway Theatre
