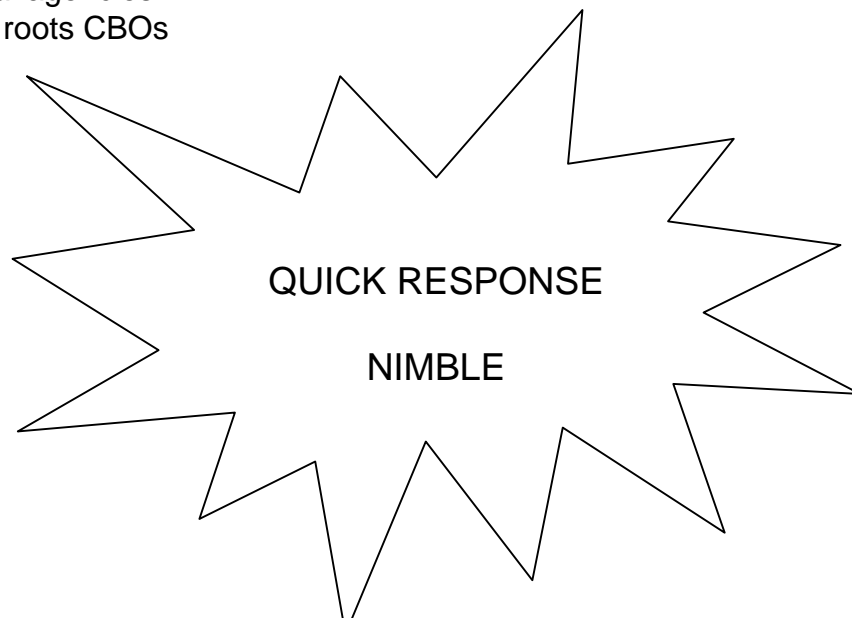

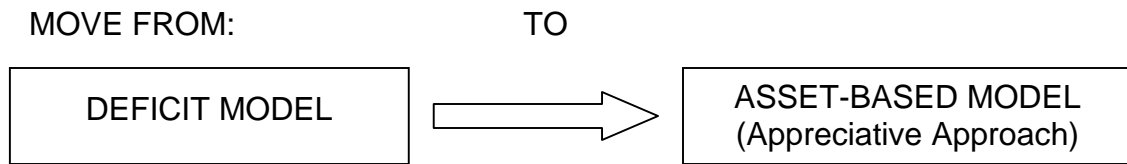

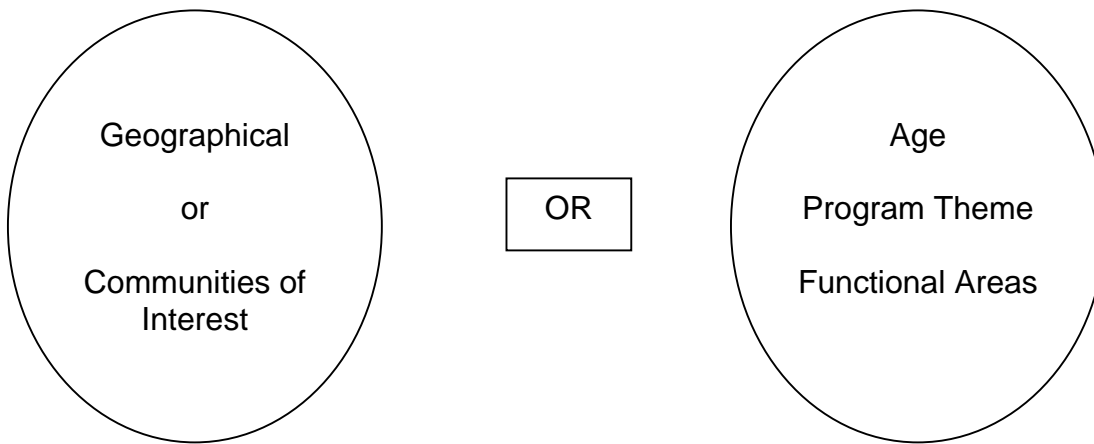

Organization by:



- General agreement with community centres as a group.
- Broaden the scope of City relationships/investments to ensure a broader reach.
- Start with City-wide functional/age grouping.
- Contract City-wide service provider.
- Umbrella group to provide city-wide insight.
- Help understand the community better.
- Identify core services.
- Provide an opportunity for all to partake.
 1. Needs Assessment indicates approximately 50% want to get more involved.
- “Richmond One Card” for integrated customer service across city.
- Do what “Makes Sense.”
- Centralized “monitoring/coordinating” mechanism by the City.
