Welcome Group Visitors!

Thank you for visiting Britannia Shipyards National Historic Site. We hope that your self-guided group visit will be both educational and fun! The following guidelines are set out to ensure a great visit by your group:

- Children under 13 years old are required to be within a close proximity to an adult.
- Boardwalks and building entrances are to be kept clear for other visitors.
- Food and beverages in site buildings are not permitted.
- Bikes are to be locked up at bike racks.
- Artefacts are not to be touched with the exception of the interactive exhibit components.
- Running in the buildings is not permitted.
- Climbing on fences, trees and boats is not permitted.
- Large groups should be divided into smaller groups of 10 maximum as small house exhibits have limited space.

Field and picnic tables are available for use. All garbage should be disposed of in on-site garbage cans.

The guidelines above, and the staff and volunteers who enforce them, are to be respected.
