



Inspect the Voters List

The City of Richmond uses the Province of BC's Voters List for elections. The Voters List will be available for public inspection at City Hall starting on **September 1 at 8:15am** until **October 17, 2026 at 8:00pm**.

You are required to make an appointment if you intend to inspect the Voters List. You must sign a statement that you will only inspect the list for the purposes of the election.

For personal privacy purposes, you have the right to request that your name and/or address be omitted from or obscured on the Voters List. Please contact the Richmond Elections Office to make an appointment to complete this request by **August 25 at 5:00pm**.

You can only object to the registration of a person on the Voters List if the person is deceased or not qualified to vote in Richmond. To make an objection, please contact the Richmond Elections Office to make an appointment. Objections must be made by **4:00pm on September 11**.
