COVID-19 Public Program Guidelines

- Do not attend your lesson if you:
 - are feeling ill and/or have any of the following symptoms: fever, chills, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, new muscle aches or headache or sore throat;
 - have been in close contact with a person who has a confirmed or presumptive case of COVID-19 within the past 14 days.
 - have travelled outside Canada within the last 14 days.
 - have someone in your household that has travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days.
- Register online at www.richmond.ca/register or call the Registration Call Centre at 604-276-4300, Monday to Friday, 8:30am to 5:00pm.
- Bring previous report card to first class.
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes before your scheduled time.
- Maintain a minimum of 2 metres physical distance at all times.
- Wash and/or disinfect your hands when entering the facility and before going on the ice.
- Follow directional arrows and signage as part of physical distancing.
- Listen carefully to staff and follow their instructions closely.
- Each registered participant may have **ONE** parent/guardian enter the facility with the skater to help with equipment. This person must exit the facility once skater steps on the ice for their lesson and parent/guardian may return 5 minutes before lesson ends to help skater take off equipment and exit the building. Wear a face mask upon entering and exiting the building. Skaters may remove their face masks to skate, parents/guardians to wear face mask at all times while in the facility.
- Exit the facility within 10 minutes of your session end time.
- Follow directional signage to the exit doors, which may not be the same doors you entered.
- Wash and/or disinfect your hands when exiting the building.
