

Traffic Advisory: Speed Limit Reduction in Steveston Neighborhood

Effective November 15, 2024

Overview:

The City of Richmond has implemented amendments to Traffic Bylaw No. 5870, reducing the posted speed limit on all roads within the Steveston neighborhood from 50 km/h to 30 km/h. This change aims to enhance road safety in the area.

Traffic Impact:

The new speed limit of 30 km/h is effective as of November 15, 2024. Although the reduced speed limit is already in effect, advisory signs will be posted shortly to remind drivers of this adjustment.

Area Affected:

The speed limit reduction applies to all roads within Steveston, bounded by:

- West: Property line of Seventh Avenue
- South: Property line of Steveston Highway
- East: Property line of No. 1 Road
- North: Property line of Chatham Street

Driver Advisory:

All motorists are reminded to adhere to the updated speed limits and observe posted signs as they are installed. Reducing speeds within the Steveston neighborhood will help create a safer environment for all road users. Refer to the map on the next page for more details.
