



Traffic Advisory: Steveston Highway Multi-Use Pathway Construction

Effective September 21, 2026

The City of Richmond is advising the public that construction will begin the week of September 21, 2026, to complete the Steveston Multi-Use Pathway connection between Railway Avenue and the Steveston Interchange.

Construction will include a three-metre-wide asphalt multi-use pathway, tree planting and lighting upgrades along the south side of Steveston Highway between Shell Road and the Steveston Interchange.

Lane Closure Details:

- Steveston Highway: Single-lane traffic in each direction will be maintained throughout construction.
- Eastbound traffic: Traffic will be shifted to the north side of the centre median, with crossovers at intersections.
- Eastbound curb lane: Closed throughout construction.
- Eastbound inside lane: Reserved for buses and emergency vehicles during work hours and reopened to general traffic after work hours and on weekends.
- Access to area shopping centres will be maintained via Coppersmith Way and No. 5 Road.

Bus stops affected by construction will be temporarily relocated in coordination with Coast Mountain Bus Company. Digital message boards, signage and traffic-control personnel will be in place to notify and guide road users through the work zone.

The public is advised that traffic delays may occur in the area during construction. Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are encouraged to plan accordingly, follow posted signage and directions from traffic-control personnel, and allow additional travel time.

The City will monitor traffic conditions throughout construction and adjust traffic-control measures as needed to maintain safety and minimize disruption.
